



HOUSE RULES ROTTERDAM PRIDE

The house rules can be found at all events and the website (www.rotterdam-pride.com) from Stichting Rotterdam Pride.

- Glass is forbidden on the event grounds.
- No big bags and backpacks allowed on the Pride Festival.
- Alcohol may only be consumed within the boundaries of the event grounds and during opening hours of the event.
- Under 18, no alcohol. When in doubt, you may be asked for your ID. The organization provides NIX18 tapes for visitors under the age of 18.
- Use and / or carrying drugs, and any form of drug trade is prohibited.
- Please place your waste in the conventional waste bins.
- Without permission from the organization, it is forbidden to sell in any form on the event grounds.
- It is forbidden to distribute advertising materials unless permission has been given by the organization. Cleaning costs will be recovered from by advertiser provider.
- When you enter the event, you agree that you can be recorded on image and / or sound carriers and that this can be used. All rights reserved.
- Entry of the event grounds is at your own risk. The organization is not liable for any injury as a result of the visit.
- At all times protection of safety on security.
- Security has the right to control visitors.
- In case of provocative behaviour, please address the security. Do not act on your own.
- Objects that might be used as weapons are not allowed on the event grounds.
- An identity card must be issued.
- Damage or loss of ownership is at your own risk, the organization does not take responsibility.
- During the Pride Walk megaphones are forbidden.
- All participants of the Pride Walk respect each other and convey their message in a friendly way.
- During the Pride Walk press must be registered and wear a press badge. Badges can be collected at the information stand of Rotterdam Pride.
- Objects longer than 2 meter are not allowed during the Pride Walk.
- Groups above 10 people must register in advance via the registration form for the Pride Walk. The organisation has the right to decline groups if others visitors safety might be affected.
